
RHMS Lunch & After-School Clubs



Over the last several years, RHMS has established an array of clubs based upon student interest and community support.

In many instances, clubs are run by teachers or community volunteers who have been screened through appropriate CUSD channels to be with students and lead activities.

In other instances, clubs are fashioned and run entirely by students with a teacher simply serving as a host, providing a classroom and supervision.



We are proud to share that our clubs are currently non-fee based. If you would like to support the expense of our RHMS Club Program, we suggest a \$40 donation. If you write a check, it can be payable to RHMS.

In all instances, clubs have minimum and maximum limits. This is to provide enough leader contact and properly compensate leaders.

The Google Form to register will fill with as many names as express interest. Club leaders will contact students to confirm entry and will maintain a wait list as necessary.
