Science Notebook Guidelines

At the end of every chapter, you will be turning in a folder (notebook) with all of the assignments from the chapter.

Notebooks

Notebooks will be turned in once every two weeks and will be accompanied by a chapter test.

Materials Needed Everyday.

- 1. Blue or black pens All written work requires writing with a blue or black pen. Pencil work will not be accepted.
- 2. Red pens All corrections require a red pen.
- 3. Highlighters, for the whole year.
- 4. Binder paper.
- 5. Folders with three prongs to turn in notebooks.
- 6. A calculator (a simple one will do for Science)
- 7. A small size Ruler for graphs.
- 8. Contribution of a **Tissue box** will be greatly appreciated.

Organization

For everyday use, you may share the same three ring binder with all of your subjects, allotting one section for science.

Your notebook will be evaluated on:

- 1. Accuracy and completion
- 2. Organization
- 3. Neatness
